The GenS Repository Manager is used to create GenS Repositories, GenS Element Manager creates and modifies the Project configuration by selecting the required standard/specification, adding project specific information, and editing the tables and fields available to ILS/IPS users within the project; and User administration tasks within GenS, to create user accounts and modify access to projects within GenS.
